Talking Points:

After reading verse 1-9

- -What is the key that unlocks the parable to the hearer?

Read verses 14 - 20

- -What are some ways we can guard against being anything but good soil?
- -Verse 23 is the same quote used in ten other places in the Bible. What is its significance? Which book of the Bible is it used the most?
- -There is a promise in verse 24-25, what is it? Does that same promise hold true for today?

-What comparison does the Kingdom of Heaven have with a mustard seed?
-If the Kingdom of Heaven is the mustard seed and we are the ground, what activates the growth?
-Is it a choice or does it just happen?
