Psalms 139

Memory Verse: Psalm 139:16 (NASB95): 16 Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in Your book were all written. The days that were ordained for me, when as yet there was not one of them.

Talking points:

Verse 1-6

-What truths does verse 1-6 reveal about God's involvement in our lives?

-Verse 5 states "you have enclosed me behind and before and have laid Your hands upon me". Then how can we get out of the will and plan of God?

-In verse 6 David says "His ways are too high to understand". When you look at God through this truth. Does it increase or lessen your faith and Peace?

-What are some thoughts or emotions that the first six verses bring to the forefront of your mind?

Verse 7-12

-Can our senses be trusted when we don't feel Gods presence in our life? What are some reasons we don't feel Gods presence at times?

-What is the significance of verse 10 stating “Your **right** hand will lay hold of me.” Is it a blessing or a curse?

-After reading these verses is God moved by our circumstances or situations?

Verse 13-16

-Why does David write? “We are fearfully and wonderfully made.

-What does these verses do to the thoughts of unplanned or a mistaken birth?

-Do we make our own choices or has God preordained our lives and we are just walking it out?

Verses 17-24

-After reading verse 17 and 18. Should anyone feel insignificant? Does this challenge or confirm your beliefs and thoughts of God attention towards you?

-In verse 23 and 24. What is David asking God to do? Should we all pray this prayer? Why don't we?
