Memory Verse: Psalm 91:14 (NASB95): 14 “Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him;

I will set him securely on high, because he has known My name.

Talking points:

Verse 1-4

- Although it doesn't state the author, who is accredited to have written it? How does this knowledge change how you view this, Psalm?

-What are the very strong descriptive words the psalmist use in the first verse?

-How does it set the tone for entire Psalm?

-What are two points that the psalmist makes in the first verse?

-How does the psalmist view the Lord in verse 2? Do you feel the same way?

-Verse 3 they accredit God with two things. What does that look like in this present day?

-When the psalmist uses the metaphor of a bird sheltering their young. What feeling does that give you? Does it accomplish what they intended?

-What characteristic of God is stated in verse 4? What can we do with that?

Verse 5-7

-What four things does the lord promise to deliver you from?

-What does that do to your faith walk?

-In verse 7 it states ten thousand at your right hand. What is the significance of that?

-What is the promise in verse 7? How do we receive it?

Verse 8-16

-What is the promise in verse 10? How can you translate that to present day?

-What does verse 11 speak about being assigned to us. Where is another verse in the Bible that says the same thing?

-Is verse 13 literal or figurative? Explain.

-What six promises does God make in the last 3 verses?

-What is the reason that the Lord states, why he will do all these things? Is it our birthright? Or relationship?

-After studying psalms 91. How has this affected your viewpoint of your relationship with God?
