-What are we stating in verse 10?

-What is the essence of verse 11-13? How do they differ from verse 9-10?

-What is the promise and truth in verse 14 and 15?

-Why are these two verses so critical to remember?

Verse 16-24

-What does Jesus define people who make their fasting a focal point?

-What does that word mean?

In verse 21 it gives an important biblical truth for us to better understand our actions.

-What is it?

-Is it just about one subject or is it all encompassing in our lives?

-In verse 22-23 is Jesus talking about our physical eyes?

- How can you change your eyes?

-What is the warning in verse 23?

-Jesus drew a line in the sand in verse 24. What does that look like in your life?

Verse 25-34

-What is Jesus's direction in verse 25? What does that look like in your life?

-Does Jesus agree with worry? Why or why not?

-In verse 30 what does Jesus say the cause of worry is?

-What is the promise of verse 33?

-What is the prophetic word that we should expect in life?
