-Why were they amazed at his answer?

Verse 18-27

-What are two of the Sadducees shortfalls? Are we as Christians in danger of the same things today?

-What Biblical foundations can you take away from Jesus's answer in verses 24-27?

Verse 28-40

-Jesus stated the greatest commandment in verse 30 and the second in verse 31. What should that look like in a believer's life?

-What is the Kingdom truth in verse 33?

-In Verse 38-40 gives us a serious warning. How do we apply this warning in this day and age?

-What were their errors?

Verse 41-44

-What were the differences between the widow and everyone else?

-What did Jesus' honor in these verses?

-What does this show us about the Father?

-What were some of the topics and truths that stood out to you in this chapter?
