-If you have some and not all the characteristics of love, what do you do?

-Read 1 John 4:7-12. When you combine those verses with this chapter. What pieces of the puzzle or revelations happen?

-Is love an emotion, will or force?

Verses 8-1

-When will the gifts cease but Love remains?

-Why will things cease?

-What is Paul saying in verse 11?

-What is the promise in verse 12?

-In verse 13 it lists three things what are they? Can they exist without each other? Explain your answer?
