Memory Verse: “After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.”

1 Peter 5:10 NASB2020

Talking points:

Verse 1-4

-What is the Glory to be revealed that Peter is referring to?

-Verse 2 states 2 proper and 2 improper motives to lead people what are they?

-What is the proper way to lead the people the Father entrusts to you?

-What does that look like in practical terms?

-Do you think Peter is talking about a physical crown in verse 4? Back up your answer biblically.

Verse 5-7

-Why would Peter instill in the Church the importance for younger people to be subject to their elders?

-What does clothing yourself in humility look like to you?

-List three other verses in the Bible where it states “God is opposed to the proud”.

-What does that say about this statement?

-What does it mean to oppose or resist?

-What does a gift of grace from God look like?

- Peter tells us to cast all our anxieties or cares on God. Is it a suggestion or a command? What is the fruit of keeping them to ourselves?

-When Peter says that God cares for us. Is he talking about the emotion of caring or the action of caring for someone? What is the difference?

-What revelations can we take from this verse alone?

Verse 8-14

-What is our responsibility to avoid attacks from the enemy? What practical ways can we do this?

-If we resist the enemy by being firm in our faith. What does that tell us about how he tries to attack?

-Do you have any testimonies of experiencing that verse?

-In verse 10 it states that God himself will perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you. Look up the meaning of those words. Then meditate on this truth. That God himself is going to do that for you.
