- -After reading verse nine through ten. What does the Love of the Father "look like"?
- -After reading verse 11. What in turn should our Love "look like"?
- -In verse 12 it states that "God has never been seen". What does that statement tie in with rest of this verse?
- -How does verse thirteen give us proof of our Salvation?

- -What does abiding in God's love look like to you? Does it come easy to you or is it a challenge?
- -If fear is a common presence in your life. What does John state that the issue is?

- -Is verse 21 an option? What does that do to our lives if we refuse?
