-How do we know a mature Christian when we see one?

-What is the difference between man's wisdom and Gods wisdom?	
-Why doesn't God reveal it to everyone on the Earth instead of his chosen people? Is it his choice?	
Verse 10-16 -What is the catalyst to receive and perceive these mysteries of God?	
-In verse 11-12 what is being stated about the Holy Spirit?	
-How should Versace 12 change how you look at yourself?	
-How does a believer put verse 13 into practice in their own life?	
-When the Holy Spirit comes and abides within us do we become Superhuman? What are some discussions for and against your answer?	
-Verse 15 gives us a powerful biblical truth. What is it?	
-How should this change the way you pray and view life's problems and issues?	
-There is a tremendous amount of meaning and truth to 1 corinthians 2. What is your take aways from this chapter?
